Allegretto Wines encompasses two vineyards within two different sub-appellations of Paso Robles. Our estate and single vineyard wines are sourced from the vineyards that surround the Allegretto Resort, as well as our westside vineyard in the Willow Creek District. Allegretto Vineyard was planted in 2012, and it includes 7 acres of vines. Located on the east side of Paso Robles, and in the Estrella District, the soils from this vineyard are alluvial in nature, and include fine sandy loams and substantial clay loams. The climate is warmer with diurnal swing of 30-40 degrees.

Allegretto Wines emphasizes biodynamic farming practices, and follows the biodynamic calendar providing detailed astronomical information and indications of optimal times for sowing, transplanting, cultivation, harvesting and using the biodynamic preparations. Biodynamic practices promote the enlivening forces that work dynamically within the soil, compost, and plants to ultimately provide us with healthier bodies, and a healthier planet.

This estate grown Cabernet Sauvignon comes from our Allegretto Vineyard. The grapes are destemmed, lightly crushed, and then fermented in stainless steel tanks for 10 days. After fermentation, the wine is placed in new and neutral French Oak barrels.
