VINEYARD DETAILS Allegretto Vineyard 807 feet Alluvial soil with sandy and clay loams

Allegretto Wines encompasses three vineyards within two different sub-appellations of Paso Robles. Our estate grown and single vineyard wines are sourced from the vineyards that surround the Allegretto Resort, as well as our westside vineyards in the Willow Creek District. Allegretto Vineyard was planted in 2012, and it includes 7 acres of vines. Located on the east side of Paso Robles, and in the Estrella District, the soils from this vineyard are alluvial in nature, and include fine sandy loams and substantial clay loams. The climate is warmer with diurnal swing of 30-40 degrees.

Allegretto Wines emphasizes biodynamic farming practices and follows the biodynamic calendar providing detailed astronomical information and indications of optimal times for sowing, transplanting, cultivation, harvesting and using the biodynamic preparations. Biodynamic practices promote the enlivening forces that work dynamically within the soil, compost, and plants to ultimately provide us with healthier bodies, and a healthier planet.

Petit Verdot grows well in the Paso Robles area, where it develops dark fruit and anise flavors. It is blended with our estate grown Cabernet Sauvignon, Malbec and Tannat just before bottling in French and American oak for complexity.
